<u>DATE</u>	<u>EVENT</u>	<u>WHAT TO EXPECT & HELPFUL HINTS</u>
	Purchase Books and Supplies	◆ Bookstore opens prior to the start of classes. See www.niagaracc.bncollege.com for hours & info.
December 19	Begin Online Purchases	◆ Online orders using Financial Aid for payment will begin processing.
December 22	Begin In-Store Purchases	◆ Return books with receipt for full refund by January 24. Return dropped course books with receipt and proof of schedule change by February 17.
January 2	100% Refund Ends for Winter 2017	◆ Last day to withdraw from Winter 2017 classes or reduce class schedule online through Banner Web without a financial liability.
January 3	Winter Intersession 2017 Classes Begin	◆ Excellent opportunity to make up classes or to reduce course load for future semesters.
January 14	Winter Intersession 2017 Classes End	◆
January 16	100% Refund Ends for Spring 2017	◆ Last day to withdraw from Spring 2017 classes or reduce class schedule online through Banner Web without a financial liability.* Remember foundation classes must be dropped in person at Registration and Records Office (A201).
January 16	Martin Luther King Day	◆ College closed.
January 17	First Day of Classes	◆ Excitement, confusion, anticipation, doubt! Having trouble finding a parking spot? – Look for space behind the buildings. (Student parking is in Lots 1, 4, and 5.)
January 17-20	Add/Drop Days	◆ Use Banner Web for necessary schedule changes or talk with an advisor at an add/drop session. Financial liability may apply. *
January 17	Grades Posted	◆ Winter Intersession 2017 grades available on Banner Web after 5 pm.
January 17-20	Welcome Week	◆ Join us for a week of activities to welcome new and returning students to campus and to celebrate a new year!
January 17 – February 4	CRISIS! Missing Classes During the First Three Weeks	◆ Visit your instructors, academic advisor, or Student Development (A131).
January 17 – February 4	Attendance Recorded	◆ Faculty must report student attendance – especially during these weeks. Failure to attend class(es) may result in a final grade of a W/withdrawal or X/withdrawal from college. This may also reduce your financial aid and leave you with a bill.
February 6	Deadline for Deleting Classes*	◆ Last day to drop a course and have it deleted from your schedule – “W” grades given after this day. Financial liability may apply. *
February 20	Presidents' Day	◆ College Closed.
March 3	Scholarship Deadline	◆ Distinguished Student Scholarship deadline for the Fall 2017 semester for incoming Niagara County High School graduates and the Statler Foundation Scholarship for the Spring 2017 semester.
March 6	Academic Deficiency E-Mail Notification	◆ The semester is well underway – assess your progress. Students in danger of failing a course may receive a warning e-mail from Academic Affairs. Follow suggestions given in the e-mail and consult with your instructor(s) and advisor.
March 7	CCI Day	◆ No classes – day or evening.
Week of March 7	First Federal Pell / Loan Refunds Issued	◆ Checks will be mailed – is your correct address on file with the Registration & Records Office (A-201)?
March 8 & 9	Grad Fair	◆ Prep for graduation. On the Sanborn Campus.

March 13-17	Spring Recess	◆ College Closed – Catch-up academically, R & R – Enjoy!
March 20	Advisement & Registration for Summer and Fall 2017 Begins	◆ Register before new students!! Schedule an appointment with your advisor to plan courses and register for next semester. This meeting is mandatory to register early – don't miss it!!
March 23	Transfer Fair	◆ College representatives on the Sanborn Campus – don't miss it!
March 23	Job & Internship Fair	◆ Sanborn Campus. Dress for success and bring your resume. See the College website for participating employers.
March 27	Last Day to Withdraw From a Class or Elect an S/U Grade	◆ Decision Day! Should a course be dropped to get a “W” grade or is the course salvageable? See your instructor. Don't wait until the last day! Dropping a course may negatively affect progress toward your degree – talk with your advisor. Dropping a course may also affect your eligibility for Financial Aid – speak to someone in the Financial Aid Office. ◆ Module classes are different. See Registration & Records (A201).
April 1	Financial Aid On-Time Deadline	◆ All students should file a FAFSA by this date to secure funds for Fall 2017 classes – don't delay! Applications filed after that date may not show up as processed aid on your bill.
April 4	Spring Health Fair	◆ Various agencies on the Sanborn Campus with FREE testing, information and giveaways related to health and wellness. There is something for everyone!
April 14	Scholarship Deadline (Fall 2017 Awards)	◆ To apply for the many NCCC scholarships available, visit the Scholarship webpage at www.niagaracc.suny.edu/scholarships .
April 14	Good Friday	◆ College Closed.
April 20	Summer Tuition Due	◆ Deadline to pay your bill if you are registered for Summer 2017 courses.
April 24	Graduation Application Deadline	◆ Login to Banner Web. Under “Student Records” select “Graduation Application – Submit”. A \$30 fee must be paid at the time of application. You cannot graduate without completing this application!
May 5	Thunderfest!	◆ Come to the 1 st annual campus wide event: Thunderfest! Thunderfest is a way for the NCCC community to come together and celebrate their NCCC pride by enjoying 7 hours of live entertainment, interactive activities and a huge selection of foods from local vendors. The night will end with a large bonfire for all to enjoy. Open to all students!
May 8-12	Final Week of Academic Activity	◆ Final week of classes. Final exams to be held during regular scheduled class times.
May 12	Last Day of Classes!	◆
May 12	Last Day to Withdraw From the College	◆ Withdrawing from all classes results in “X” grades and may affect your Financial Aid and academic standing – talk to a Student Development counselor (A131). You may withdraw from the College online through Banner Web or the form is available in Registration & Records (A201).
May 13	Commencement	◆ Congratulations graduates!!!
May 15	Grades Posted	◆ Spring 2017 grades available on Banner Web after 5 pm.
May 22	Summer Session I Begins	◆ Excellent opportunity to make up classes or to reduce course load for future semesters.
