<u>DATE</u>	<u>EVENT</u>	<u>WHAT TO EXPECT & HELPFUL HINTS</u>
Early August	Purchase Books and Supplies	◆ Bookstore opens prior to the start of classes. See www.niagaracc.bncollege.com for hours & info.
August 14	Begin SFA Purchases	◆ Student Financial Aid (SFA) may be used in the bookstore beginning on 8/14/19. SFA may be used to purchase any merchandise in the bookstore.
August 22 & 23	<u>Opening Weekend- Clubs/Activities Fair</u> Success Workshops Networking Lunch	◆ Time to learn about what NCCC can offer you through attending a clubs fair, interactive workshops, activities and programs. FREE food and MORE! Tour your schedule – <i>don't miss it! Meet faculty, staff and other new students.</i>
August 25	0% Tuition & Fee Liability Period Ends for Fall 2019*	◆ Last day to withdraw from <u>all</u> Fall 2019 classes or reduce class schedule online through Banner Web without a financial obligation. *Module classes are different. See Registration & Records (A201).
August 26	Access Starfish – Your Academic Success and Support Portal	◆ Log into Blackboard and click on “Starfish Login”. Sign up for Starfish text alerts in your profile and view your personal Success Network to see who is in your corner this semester!
August 26	First Day of Class	◆ Excitement, confusion, & anticipation! Having trouble finding parking? – Look for space <u>behind</u> the buildings. (Student parking is in lots 1, 4, and 5.)
August 26 - 29	Add/Drop Days	◆ Use Banner Web for necessary schedule changes or talk with an advisor at an Add/Drop session. Schedule changes may impact financial liability.
August 26 - 30	Welcome Week	◆ Join us for a week of activities to welcome new and returning students to campus and to celebrate a new academic year!
August 26 - September 13	<i>CRISIS!</i> Missing Classes During the First Three Weeks	◆ Visit your instructors, academic advisor, or Student Development (A131).
August 26 - September 13	Attendance Recorded	◆ Faculty must report student attendance – especially during these weeks. Failure to attend class(es) may result in a final grade of a W/withdrawal or X/withdrawal from college. This may also reduce your financial aid and leave you with a bill.
August 31	Bookstore Returns	◆ “No questions asked” full return for books (with receipt) by 08/31/19 . Return dropped course books with receipt and proof of schedule change by 09/27/19 .
September 2	Labor Day	◆ College closed.
September 10 & 11	Student Senate Elections	◆ Your chance to vote for Student Government representation and the expenditures of activity fees. Don't miss it!
September 16	Deadline for Deleting Classes*	◆ Last day to drop a course and have it deleted from your schedule – “W” grades given after this day. Financial liability remains. *Module classes are different. See Registration & Records (A201).
September 19	College Transfer Fair	◆ College representatives on Sanborn Campus – <i>don't miss it!</i>
TBA	Part Time Employment Fair	◆ On the Sanborn Campus. Dress for success and bring your resume. See the College website for participating employers.
October 2 - 11	Academic Deficiency E-Mail Notification	◆ Students in danger of failing a course may receive an e-mail from Academic Affairs via Starfish. Follow the suggestions given in the e-mail and consult with your instructor(s) and advisor.

October 4	Scholarship Deadline (Spring 2020 Awards)	◆ To apply for the many NCCC scholarships available, visit the Scholarship webpage www.niagaracc.suny.edu/scholarships
	Statler Scholarship Deadline (Fall 2019 Awards)	◆ Statler Foundation Scholarship deadline for the Fall 2019 semester.
Week of October 13	First Federal Pell/Loan Refunds Issued	◆ Checks will be mailed – is your correct address on file with the Registration & Records Office (A201)? Submit address changes online through Banner Web.
October 14	Columbus Day	◆ College Closed
October 15	Advisement & Registration for Winter & Spring 2020 Begins	◆ Register before new students!! Time to make an appointment with your advisor to plan courses and register for next semester. This meeting is mandatory to register early – <i>don't miss it!</i>
October 18 - 20	Leadership Weekend	◆ Join us for an overnight experience that offers a variety of team-building, leadership, social and networking activities that will help participants with the various roles they play at work, school, and in life. Enjoy camping, learning new things, and making new friends!
November 11	Veterans Day	◆ College closed.
November 25	Last Day to Withdraw From a Class or Elect an S/U Grade	◆ Decision Day! Should a course be dropped to get a “W” grade or is the course salvageable? See your instructor. Don't wait until the last day! Dropping a course may negatively affect your progress toward your degree – talk with your advisor. Dropping a course may also affect your eligibility for Financial Aid – speak to someone in the Financial Aid Office. *Module classes are different. See Registration & Records (A201).
November 25	Last Day to Withdraw From the College - Financial Liability Remains	◆ Withdrawing from all classes results in “X” grades and may affect your Financial Aid and academic standing – talk to a Student Development counselor (A131). You may withdraw from the College online through Banner Web or the form is available in Registration & Records (A201). *Module classes are different. See Registration & Records (A201).
November 28 – December 1	Thanksgiving	◆ College closed.
December 5	Winter and Spring Tuition Due	◆ Deadline to pay your bill if you are registered for the Winter Session and/or Spring 2020 courses.
December 9 - 14	Final Week of Classes	◆ Last chance to show what you know! Final exams to be held during regular scheduled class times.
December 13	Graduation Application Deadline	◆ Login to Banner Web. Under “Student Records” select “Graduation Application – Submit”. You cannot graduate without completing this application! If you are earning a degree and a certificate or more than one degree, be sure to apply for BOTH!
December 16	Grades Posted	◆ Fall 2019 grades available on Banner Web after 5 pm.
January 2	Winter Session Registration Add/Drop Deadline	◆ Last day to register for and add/drop winter session courses.
January 2 - 13	Winter Session	◆ Excellent opportunity to make up classes or to reduce course load for future semesters.
