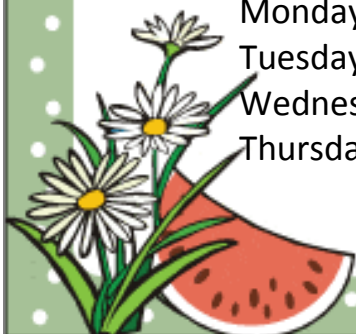

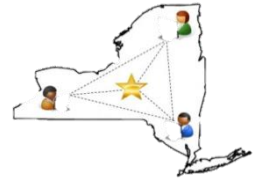


STAR-NY Online Tutoring Services

What is STAR-NY?

- STAR-NY is an online tutoring service students can use when traditional tutoring does not fit into their schedule.



How Does it Work?

- Students enter a virtual room to work with a tutor one-on-one.
- Papers and/or problems are loaded onto the WorldWideWhiteboard, allowing both the tutor and tutee to work within the same space.
- A chat box is used for the tutor and tutee to communicate.
