

Welcome to MyMathTest! We have set up a Practice Test for you to take (Unlimited Attempts) before you take the actual NCCC Math Aptitude Test (TWO Attempts).

## HOW TO REGISTER AND ENROLL IN THE PROGRAM

The program name is: NCCC Math Placement

To join this program, you need to register for MyMathTest and then enroll in the program.

## **STEP 1: REGISTERING FOR MYMATHTEST**

To register, go to <a href="www.mymathtest.com">www.mymathtest.com</a> click on the **Student** button below where it says **Register Now**, and then follow the instructions on the screen. You will need a valid email address, the Program ID (below) and the following Access Code:

ACCESS CODE: WSSMMT-CHUFF-FLOOD-SEGUE-DOLBY-MUSES

**IMPORTANT**: Click on "No" for "Do you have a Pearson account". For your login name you **MUST** use:

<u>Login name</u>: First initial and full last name followed by birthday in MM-DD-YYYY format with no spaces (dashes included). For example, John Smith was born on January 1, 1999 so his login name would be: ismith01-01-1999

Finally: The zip-code for NCCC is 14132.

#### STEP 2: ENROLLING IN THE NCCC MATH PLACEMENT PROGRAM

After registering, log in to MyMathTest with your username and password. To enroll in this program, enter the following:

Program ID for your program is: XL34-41DZ-301Z-90W2

## STEP 3: PRACTICING AND TAKING THE NCCC MATH APTITUDE TEST

After you enter the program ID click on **Take a Test** from the left side. You are encouraged to take the **NCCC Math Practice Test (TAKE THIS FIRST - Unlimited Attempts)** several times until you earn a grade you are comfortable with. Note that you will see your score immediately and you can review the test after submitting.

When you feel you are ready, click on **Take a Test** from the left side and then choose **NCCC Math Aptitude Test (TWO Attempts / Password is: NCCC).** You have only TWO ATTEMPTS and MyMathTest will only count your best score. It is password protected and the password is **NCCC**. Good Luck!

# **STEP 4: INTERPRETING YOUR SCORES**

A score greater than or equal to 60% places a student in MAT 023, MAT 104 or MAT 106 depending on major.

A score greater than or equal to 75% places a student in MAT 104, MAT 106, MAT 108, or MAT 110.
